As an organisation that is immensely proud of its Jewish heritage, we express our strong support for the State of Israel, its people, and their security.

## We believe in:

- The right of Israel to exist as a modern and democratic Jewish State
- The right of the Israeli people to live within secure borders
- Israel's continued protection of the rights and freedoms of all its citizens and minority groups

We will not work with people or organisations that work against the interests of Israel's legitimate rights as a sovereign state including organisations supporting the Boycott Divestments and Sanctions movement, funding or supporting terrorist activities or preaching hate and intolerance.

We seek constructive ways to advance the relationship between the Australian Jewish community, the wider Australian community and the State of Israel, particularly in areas of common interest.

Jewish Care has a long history of supporting refugees and asylum seekers and we will continue to make our services available to refugees and asylum seekers, supporting them to reach their full potential.
