As our in-home services is a commercial service fees will apply. Subsidies may be available for some seniors, people with disabilities and eligible Holocaust survivors. We may also be able to offer more competitive rates than you are currently being charged.

It is our aim to ensure that no one is disadvantaged by their financial circumstances.

We do not charge any entry or exit fees.

Prior to commencement of services a Jewish Care representative will visit you and develop a holistic plan tailored to your unique needs. Our office staff will find the right in-home care staff for you and help you to manage your in-home care services. Our qualified case managers, assessment officers and support workers will:

- Discuss and develop an individual plan with you to meet your goals and evaluate your needs on a regular basis
- Help you navigate a complex disability and aged care system
- Help you to continue to stay connected to your community and do things you like to do
- Assist you in maintaining independence at home
- Assist you in accessing other available services

In-Home Services

Our in-home services are available every day of the week and we are able to assist you with:

- Domestic tasks and duties (vacuuming, washing, ironing etc)
- Assistance with meal preparations
- Assistance with personal care, hygiene and medication
- Social activities and outings
- Escorted and unescorted shopping
- Assisted transport to appointments, community venues and events
- Companionship
- Respite for carers
- Overnight care
- Nursing care
- Basic maintenance and gardening

Our in-home services support team is available to answer your calls from 5.00am to 11.00pm, 7 days per week.

Care Packages

The right care package will allow you to choose a range of in-home care and other services to maintain your independence in your own home, in familiar surroundings and close to your support network.

You can choose from many different services that come together to make up your personal care package supported by compassionate support and advice from our qualified case managers. Each package can be modified to meet your individual requirements and can pay for such services as:

- In-home care services
- Therapies

- Mobility equipment (eg: walking frames)
- Dental care
- Podiatry
- Home modifications
- Taxi and more

Some care packages or services are funded by the Federal Government. If you are eligible, you may be asked to contribute towards the cost of your care where your personal circumstance allow.
